Dear Members of United Blood Trackers Organization (UBT),

Nominations for Regional Directors are now open!

The United Blood Trackers Board of Directors has amended the bylaws of our organization for the addition of two Regional Directors to the UBT Board of Directors. These Regional Directors will represent their region at monthly meetings of the Board of Directors and will serve as liaisons to the Board of Directors from their respective regions. Regional Directors will be nominated and elected by the membership from each respective region. For the purpose of electing Regional Directors, the UBT membership has been divided into two regions, the “Northern Region” and the “Southern Region”.

Northern Region. Alaska, Colorado, Connecticut, Delaware, Idaho, Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Kansas, Maine, Maryland, Massachusetts, Michigan, Minnesota, Missouri, Montana, Nebraska, Nevada, New Hampshire, New Jersey, New York, North Dakota, Ohio, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, South Dakota, Utah, Vermont, Washington, Wisconsin, Wyoming, Canada, and the rest of the World (with the exceptions of Mexico and South America).

Southern Region. Alabama, Arizona, Arkansas, California, Florida, Georgia, Hawaii, Kentucky, Louisiana, Mississippi, New Mexico, North Carolina, Oklahoma, South Carolina, Tennessee, Texas, Virginia, West Virginia, Mexico and South America.

This letter is the first step in the election process. Nominations will be open starting July 1st and running through August 31st. Any member can nominate any other member but you can only nominate a member from your own Region. Nominations must be made on an official Nomination Form which is enclosed here and can be downloaded from the UBT website or requested by mail or email from the UBT Secretary. Complete Nomination Forms must be RECEIVED by August 31st at the address on the form. Please note that it is the responsibility of the person submitting the nomination to get the acceptance of the nomination in writing from the person whom they have nominated and that acceptance must be submitted with the Nomination Form by the deadline.

Once nominated, all nominees have the opportunity to voluntarily submit up to a one page biography about themselves that will be mailed out to all members in their region with the ballot. Biographies must be received by September 30th.

In October, ballots will be US Postal Service mailed out to all UBT members in good standing as of September 1st in each region. Members will complete their ballots and return their ballots by US Postal Service mail. Completed ballots must be RECEIVED back by November 15th.

Please note that UBT has contracted with YesElections/Election America to conduct this process. Please look for important information in your mail from them.

It will be an honor to be nominated, elected, and to serve as an UBT Regional Director. We look forward to the membership’s participation in filling these important positions.
