This year, 2025, the UBT board of directors have set a \$2,000.00 judge expense subsidy maximum (SM) for Events.

A host organization may apply for a judge expense subsidy if the total judge expenses (AT) exceed the combined income from test fees (I) and other event-generated funds intended to cover judge expenses.

If approved, the subsidy will first be used to reimburse judges for any out-of-pocket expenses that have not yet been reimbursed. This portion of the subsidy will be sent directly to the judge.

The host organization may then request part or all of the remaining subsidy to cover judge expenses exceeding the combined income from test fees and other event-generated funds intended for judge expenses. This portion of the subsidy will be sent to the event chairperson.
